## Youth Independence Program Kicks Off

BISM's summer youth Work To Independence program, for blind and low vision high school students, kicks off June 16, and the Independence 101 program, for blind middle school students, begins July 20.

Students will participate in life skills classes at the BISM Baltimore location and reside on the UMBC campus. Students will take part in confidence-building activities, day trips to New York City and Washington D.C., and spend a week at the NFB National Convention in Orlando. High school students will have a two-week work experience at a local business or organization, and the graduation ceremony takes place on August 3.
